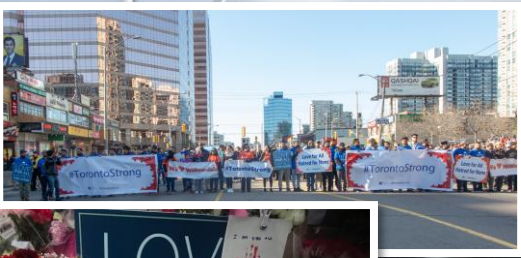


# Photojournalism workshop: Your story in a photo

2. You are at least 16 years of age and will sign a consent form (under 18 years old your legal guardian will sign).

It is your choice whether to participate in the competition or whether to have your photo considered for public display at the Café (not required).
